What Are Cookies?

Cookies are tiny text files stored on your browser. We use cookies to help us to improve your experience. Most websites use cookies and they won't cause any harm to your device. OpenVision uses cookies to help us see which pages our customers like and which aren't working so well, so we can make improvements. Cookies don't tell us who you are or give us any personal details about you.

If you do not accept the cookies you will still be able to browse our site but some parts of the site will not work.

Which Cookies Do We Use On This Site And Why?

The table below sets out the main cookies that we use on this site and what we use them for.

Google Analytics cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited. Internet Explorer

1. Click on Tools > Internet Options in the main toolbar
2. Select the Privacy tab to view your settings
3. Move the slider to the level of privacy you prefer - privacy levels are shown in the table below.

Google Chrome

Click the spanner icon in the top right-hand corner of the browser and select Settings from the drop-down menu.

Safari (Mac Only)

Click on Safari in the toolbar, then select Preferences from the drop-down menu.

Click Privacy to view cookie preferences (note: Safari blocks third-party cookies by default).
